HOW TO GET TO THE INSTITUTE

From the Chopin Airport

BY BUS

Please, take a bus 188 (direction – Gołtawek Wschodni) from Chopin Airport. You should get off at the POMNIK LOTNIKA bus stop. It's 15th stop and ride takes about 20-25 minutes. Than you have to take a bus 167 from the same bus stop, and get off at the WIŚNIOWA stop. It takes about 8-10 minutes. You need two single fare tickets (2x 4,40 PLN)

BY TAXI

The ride should cost about 30-40 PLN

The address: 4 RAKOWIECKA St. – the corner with WIŚNIOWA St. (the entrance is on WIŚNIOWA St.)

From the Central Railway Station

BY BUS

Please, take a bus 174 (direction – Bokserska). The ride will take about 10 min. You should get off at the METRO POLE MOKOTOWSKIE bus stop. It's on Niepodległości Ave. (see the localisation scheme). Than walk along Rakowiecka street about 400 meters. You need one single fare tickets (4,40 PLN).

BY TRAM

Please, take a tram 17, 37 (direction – Służewiec), 33 (direction – Kielecka) or 41 (direction – Woronicza). The ride will take about 110 min. You should get off at the METRO POLE MOKOTOWSKIE bus stop. It's on Niepodległości Ave. (see localisation scheme). Than walk along Rakowiecka street about 400 meters. You need one single fare tickets (4,40 PLN).

BY TAXI

The ride should cost about 20 PLN.

The address: 4 RAKOWIECKA St. – the corner with WIŚNIOWA St. (the entrance is from WIŚNIOWA St.)
